#### Control of Flying Insect Pests

Regular monitoring is done to identify breeding areas of flying pests.

For flying insects pests, thermal fogging / are introduced in an enclosure as fumes or

mist thereby allowing the pesticides to stay

suspended in air for a longer period to kill all

flying insects.

#### RODENT COTNROL

Rodent shall be controlled using baits and traps.

Permanent baiting stations shall be set in strategic locations, which show signs of rodent

activity. Mice, on the other hand, shall be controlled using sticky and/or mechanical traps.

#### **GEL BAITING**

Gel baiting will be used to areas where ant and

cockroach population is prevalent or on sensitive areas where spraying is not possible

Spots of bit are applied on surfaces, cracks and

crevices and other hiding areas of ant and cockroaches.

#### TERMITE TREATMENT

Inspection of the entire premise will be conducted to pinpoint termite infestations. Application of termiticide solution on areas found infested by termites will be done. Regular monthly

inspection shall be rendered on the entire premise. If a termite infestation is discovered which will involve major works in the

treatment

(i.e. drilling) then such major works is included The COTNRACTOR will provide the
