Installation of rat baits in sensitive areas have to be informed with Sports Facilities Division for approval and coordination.</p> <p>MANPOWER REQUIREMENT The contractor will assign one (1) permanent Pest Control Technician to be assigned at the PSC to carry out the works specified. 	<p>developing insecticidal resistance.</p> <p>Control of Flying Insect Pests</p> <p>Regular monitoring is done to identify breeding areas of flying pests.</p> <p>For flying insects pests, thermal fogging / are introduced in an enclosure as fumes or mist thereby allowing the pesticides to stay suspended in air for a longer period to kill all flying insects.</p> <p>RODENT COTNROL</p> <p>Rodent shall be controlled using baits and traps.</p> <p>Permanent baiting stations shall be set in strategic locations, which show signs of rodent activity. Mice, on the other hand, shall be controlled using sticky and/or mechanical traps.</p> <p>GEL BAITING</p> <p>Gel baiting will be used to areas where ant and cockroach population is prevalent or on sensitive areas where spraying is not possible</p> <p>Spots of bit are applied on surfaces, cracks and crevices and other hiding areas of ant and cockroaches.</p> <p>TERMITE TREATMENT</p> <p>Inspection of the entire premise will be conducted to pinpoint termite infestations.
