Kata requirement: all Heian, Pinan, Gekisai
Kata may be repeated alternately, not consecutively

18 years old & ABOVE SENIOR GIRLS

Kumite Female -50 kg.

Time Limit: 2 Mins, or 8 Point Lead

I. Entries:

Each participating club/organization may field in a maximum number of entries in each event. However, only a maximum of 800 players will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

All ages must be as of the competition date (May 29, 2019).

Proof of age (photocopy birth certificate, passports, etc...) must be submitted to the Organizing Committee together with the entry forms and waivers on or before the deadline May 26, 2019 . Your registration of forms will be based on entry forms submitted.

II. KPI Tournament Requirements

1. All participants must provide for their own medical expense / insurance.
2. All participants must wear clean white karate gi. Only a maximum of 3"x4" club/Organization badge on left breast is allowed.
3. All kata competitors must provide for their own red belt and blue belt.
4. All kumite competitors must provide for their own red and blue gloves, mouthgard (gum shields), red and blue belt, red and blue shin/instep guards. Chest protectors.
5. The Organizing Committee must first approve all protective gears and body protectors before they can be used except for **Cadets, Juniors and Seniors division WKF approved gears** will be used.
6. All participants must be able to present proof of age (birth certificate, passport, etc) or face disqualification. All ages must be as of date of championships. Please submit all required documents.

III. Tournament Rules

WKF Rules of Competition will be strictly enforced including the following:

1. MOUTHGUARD (gum shields) is REQUIRED in all kumite competitors.
2. For Beginners Kata only Heian shodan, Pinan Nidan and Taikyoku kata is allowed. They may repeat their Kata.
3. For Intermediate Kata all Heian, Pinan or Gekisai. Kata may be performed. They may repeat their kata but alternately but not consecutively.
4. For advance kata, Only Kata from the 4 major styles plus shorinryu are allowed. WKF rules no repetition.
5. The person in charge of submitting the entries confirm that all competitors have been advised of the risk of kumite competitions and that they fully realize and accept these risks.

IV. Tournament Officials

Only KPI and officially invited Referees and Judges shall officiate in the Championships.

V. Accommodations

No arrangements for accommodations.

VI. Other Expenses

Food, transportation, medical and other incidental expenses are to be shouldered by the participating clubs/organizations or individuals.

VIII. Drawings/Pairings

Computerized pairings will be done on May 28, 2019.

IX. Weigh-In

All weight category kumite participants must weigh-in on the day of the championships at the venue, before the tournament.

X. Awarding Ceremonies

Each tournament date is to be culminated by awarding ceremonies for all events of the day. Winners must attend the awarding ceremonies in proper attire (white karategi or track suit and no shoes/sandals) to receive their awards or they forfeit their awards. No proxies allowed.

XI. Deadline:

All entry forms together with proof of age must be received by Karate Pilipinas Organizing Committee on or before May 26, 2019. Please requirements and waivers.
