CATERER'S RESPONSINILITIES FOR PROTOCOL/VIP TECHNICAL OFFICIALS, MEDIA, ATHLETES, TEAM OFFICIALS AND WORKFORCE FOR THE CLOSING CEREMONY

Caterer will be responsible for the Delegates hospitality in the NEW CLARK CITY.

- 10. The Caterer will submit detailed utility requirements for all its operations within the **NEW CLARK CITY**. Utilities include electricity, potable water, drainage, and plumbing. PHISGOC will supply these utilities at a cost to the caterer to temporary facilities located within the **NEW CLARK CITY**. PHISGOC will manage the distribution and final hook-up of utilities and drainage within the **NEW CLARK CITY** in accordance with the specifications supplied by the Caterer (subject to final approval and revision by PHISGOC).
- 11. Caterer will be responsible for cleaning within all kitchen, support and 'non-public' areas under its management during the **Closing** Ceremony. Caterer may be required to take responsibility for cleaning within dining areas subject to the housekeeping strategy of PHISGOC. At the end of the operations, the Caterer will be required to leave all areas being vacated in a clean and tidy condition, with any deficiencies being remedied at its expense.
- 14. Caterer will be required to do a full presentation of all types of meals and beverages to be served during the **Closing Ceremony**. The presentation will be conducted prior to the **Closing Ceremony**, for approval by PHISGOC.

CATERING SERVICE CLOSING CEREMONY FOR PROTOCOL/VIP, TECHNICAL OFFICIALS, MEDIA ATHLETES, TEAM OFFICIALS AND WORKFORCE

- B. Closing Ceremony Proper
- a. 5 Minimum of 350 catering personnel. Assign at least one (1) Head waiter that shall serve as point person on every lounges. The **Closing Ceremony Caterer**, may at all times, provide additional staff that is deemed necessary in the successful conduct and delivery of kitchen and dining lounges operations
- Catering Services for the 30th South East Asian Games For Athletes and Team Officials Halal Catering Services (Lot 5)

"ANNEX "A" I. Caterer's Responsibilities:

- A. Catering Service for Athletes and Team Officials
- 2. Caterer will be responsible for the Athletes and Team Officials hospitality in the Athletes lounges located at competition venues and dining lounges of hotels of Manila, Clark, Subic & SOLO or in

common dining lounge (temporary structure) set-up where they are near billeted.

10. The Caterer will submit detailed utility requirements for all its operations within the Manila competition venues and common dining lounge temporary structures of Manila, Clark, Subic & SOLO. Utilities include electricity, potable water, drainage, and plumbing. PHISGOC will supply these utilities at a cost to the caterer to temporary facilities located within the identified areas. PHISGOC will manage the distribution and final hook-up of utilities and drainage in accordance with the specifications supplied by the Caterer (subject to final approval and revision by PHISGOC).

II. Caterer's Scope of Works

B. Games Proper

Provision of uniformed and well-trained workforce that shall work on two shifts to work on the following areas: Food preparations; Assist in the serving of foods and beverages; Maintain order and cleanliness of the **dining lounges**; and Muslim staff to handle halal food station.

Minimum of 5 catering personnel will be assigned for each Manila competition venues, designated hotel dining lounges and common dining lounges (temporary structure) within Manila, Clark, Subic & SOLO. Assign at least one (1) Head waiter that shall serve as point person on every shift. The Caterer, may at all times, provide additional staff that is deemed necessary in the successful conduct and delivery of kitchen and front of the"

2. That on the Application Form for Eligibilty and Checklist, Item No. 9 should be:

9. Certificate of Commendation of Satisfactory Performance from clients. End User's Certificate of Commendation of Satisfactory Performance issued by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) for bidders who have contract/s with the PSC to be issued by the Medical Scientific and Athletes Services Head.
