Invitation for Negotiated Procurement (Two Failed Biddings)

The Philippine Sports Commission, through its Bids & Awards Committee, invites technically, legally and financially capable service providers to participate in the negotiation of the project:

The prospective service provider shall possess a similar contract amounting to fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. Negotiation shall be conducted in accordance with Section 53.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 (Negotiated Procurement – Two Failed Biddings). The Contract for Security Services shall be for a period of three (3) years from receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

- There is a prima facie evidence of collusion;
- The BAC failed to follow the prescribed bidding procedures;
- There is/are justifiable ground/s where the contract will not redound to the benefit of the government without incurring any liability to the affected bidder/s.
